



Field day at the Pfänderhof on 5.7.2018: On the way to the best individual composting on the farm

The farm managers of the Pfänderhof are experts in composting. Visitors to the field day were able to benefit from their many years of experience with various techniques. The conditions are particularly interesting - without animal husbandry and with intensive vegetable cultivation, the raw material presents a particular challenge. At the same time, vegetable crops have a considerable need for nutrients. The visit to the composting areas was rounded off with technical presentations on the results of GHG monitoring in the project and background information from the advisory service.
