

On June 10, 2015 a field day took place on [Kornkammer Haus Holte](#) in Dortmund-Lütgendortmund and Witten with practical insights on the topic "Climate-friendly agriculture". Climate change is also felt in this region. "Since 2005, we are experiencing pronounced spring droughts and when it rains, there is frequent heavy rainfall," said Dirk Liedmann who manages along with Bernhard Pawliczek the farm. For the farmers, who work according to the criteria of organic association Bioland for 23 years, climate and nature conservation are a labor of love.

The thematic focus of the field day was the removal of the first grass clover cut for biogas production. On field visits and lectures the topic was lighted from different angles. These were supplemented by a practical introduction to integrated operational nature conservation measures by the Bioland nature conservation advisory team.
