



Field day at the Kornkammer Haus Holte on 18.06.2018: More potential for Klee with biogas cooperations

At the SOLMACC farm Kornkammer Haus Holte in Witten, the energetic use of red clover in a biogas plant demonstrates a more climate-friendly cultivation method compared to the maize that is otherwise widely used. A presentation on the results of GHG monitoring in the project rounded off the event.
